In-Person Worship:

Effective July 16, 2021 Ontario moved into Phase III of its Reopening Plan. Much of how we were operating since we reopened for worship on Sunday, June 20, 2021 remains unchanged. The salient change is the Ontario percentage restriction for capacity has been replaced with *capacity limited to permit physical distancing of 2 metres* (<https://www.ontario.ca/page/reopening-ontario#section-2>). Further, the Diocese of Toronto has instructed churches within the Diocese to remain in Amber Phase for the time being in order to keep our churches safe for all that enter. Please note the following:

- ✓ Registration required; protocols established in the fall of 2020 will be in place (e.g. no singing, Eucharist in bread only, contact tracing, social distancing, masks, etc.).
- ✓ Registration is available online on our website via Eventbrite or you may leave a message at the church.
- ✓ Our Sunday morning in-person service will be at 10:00 am.
- ✓ We will continue to offer Church Online at 10:00 am.
